

State Energy Sector Partnership Grant (SESP) – Summary
April 8 State Council Meeting

Awarded January 29, 2010 - expires January 28, 2013

Grant provides **\$4,600,000** to develop and deliver training to over 1400 customers in green construction, alternative fuels, energy management and renewable energy transmission. 1470 individuals will be served in the following target Populations:

- Dislocated Workers
- Disadvantaged youth
- Veterans
- At-risk workers impacted by energy and environmental policy (in need of skills upgrades/at-risk for job loss)

Energy Training Academies will be established to serve individuals statewide. All training and placement activities, supplies, materials and equipment will be provided at no cost to program participants. Training academies are;

1. SLCC for Box Elder, Wasatch Front (Salt Lake, Utah, Summit, Tooele, Wasatch, Davis, Weber, and Morgan)
2. East / Southeast (Uintah, Carbon, Emery, Grand, San Juan, Daggett, and Duchesne)
3. Southwest (Juab, Millard, Iron, Beaver, Washington, Garfield, Kane, Wayne, Piute, Sevier and Sanpete)
4. Davis Applied Technology College

As the One-Stop Operator DWS and the State Workforce Investment Board is responsible to provide;

1. Statewide oversight, guidance and technical assistance (1 Project Manager)
2. Recruitment, identification and referral of potential students
3. Case management to each student referred to the training academy
4. A comprehensive data base for tracking students and associated outcomes
5. Energy Career Development Specialists (6) to coordinate with the Energy Academies to provide both pre and post career guidance
6. Guidance to regional project teams to establish pathways for referral to training and one-stop services
7. Training to all one-stop employees in established pathways
8. LMI in support of regional sector targets, workforce and strategies
